### Rodeo Rules

1. Local events are open to contestants that do not hold a professional rodeo card (PRCA, PBR, CCPRA, WPRA, etc.) and reside in counties adjacent to Mendocino County.
2. All post entries, or entries **postmarked after August 25, 2017** will be subject to an additional **\$10.00 late fee**.
3. Entries to events subject to limitation according to livestock availability. First signed up and paid, first entered.
4. This event is under the sole direction of the RVCR
5. The decision of the judges and timers is final.
6. The management assigns stock, those who disagree will forfeit.
7. Contestants must be ready on the second call.
8. All entries must be accompanied by **check or money order**, no money, no entry. Entries rodeo weekend **cash only**.
9. No substitutes allowed. Must declare partners for Team Branding, Team Roping, Hide Race at check-in if not done on entry. TR and HR only enter once.
10. Contestants must comply with all rules. RVCR Management requests that contestants refrain from drinking and obnoxious behavior during the rodeo and in or about the arena/chute/stock pen/warm-up area on foot/horseback. Please deposit cans and bottles in recycle bins.
11. All rough stock contestants must supply their own equipment. Bronc ride OK to use stock saddle, bareback rigging, or bronc saddle.
12. The management assumes NO responsibility for any injury to any livestock or contestant
13. All contestants must wear cowboy hat, boots, pants, and long sleeve shirt.
14. Dogs must be leashed at all times.

### Waiver

I know that being in a rodeo can be a potentially hazardous activity. I assume all risks associated with this event, including but not limited to falls, injuries to me, my child, or my horse. Having read this waiver and knowing these facts and in consideration of RVCR accepting my entry, I, for myself, or for my child, and anyone entitled to act on my behalf, waive and release the Round Valley Community Rodeo Committee, County of Mendocino, Covelo Community Park, Round Valley Lions/Lioness Clubs, the directors/officers of all entities listed above and all sponsors, their representatives, and successors, from all claims for liability that may arise out of negligence or carelessness on the part of the persons/groups named in this waiver.
