Rodeo Rules

- 1. All events are 18 & under, Age as of September 1, 2019
- 2. All post entries, or entries postmarked after August 23, 2019 will be subject to an additional \$10.00 late fee.
- Entries to events subject to limitation according to livestock availability.
- 4. This event is under the sole direction of the R.V.C.R. The decision of the judges and timers is final.
- 5. The management assigns stock, those who disagree will forfeit.
- 6. Contestants must be ready on the second call.
- 7. All entries must be accompanied by money, no money, no entry. Cash on rodeo weekend please.
- 8. No substitutes allowed.
- 9. Contestants must comply with all rules. Unsportsman-like conduct or abuse of livestock will result in disqualification.
- 10. Steer Daubing money won will not count towards all-around for those entered in Tie Down or Breakaway Roping.
- 11. All rough stock contestants must supply their own equipment. Protective vests and helmets required. Calf or Steer will depend on size of rider/stock.
- 12. Sheep riders must wear helmets and must supply their own.
- 13. Contestants entered in the wrong age group will forfeit.
- 14. The management assumes NO responsibility for any injury to any livestock or contestant
- 15. All contestants must wear cowboy hat, boots, pants, and long sleeve shirt.
- 16. No stud horses are allowed.
- 17. Dogs must be leashed at all times.
- 18. Awards: All around will be tallied by total monies won. There will be All Around buckle for 13 and under boy or girl, 14-18 boy and 14-18 girl. Must compete in more than one event for All Around. No ground-split of entry money if no scores/times in any event. Sheep riding buckle will be awarded to highest score or longest time ridden.

Waiver

I know that being in a rodeo can be a potentially hazardous activity. I assume all risks associated with this event, including but not limited to falls, injuries to me, my child, or my horse.
